Forest Headquarters in the Brule Area DNR Office located one mile south of US 2 on Ranger Road in Brule, WI.

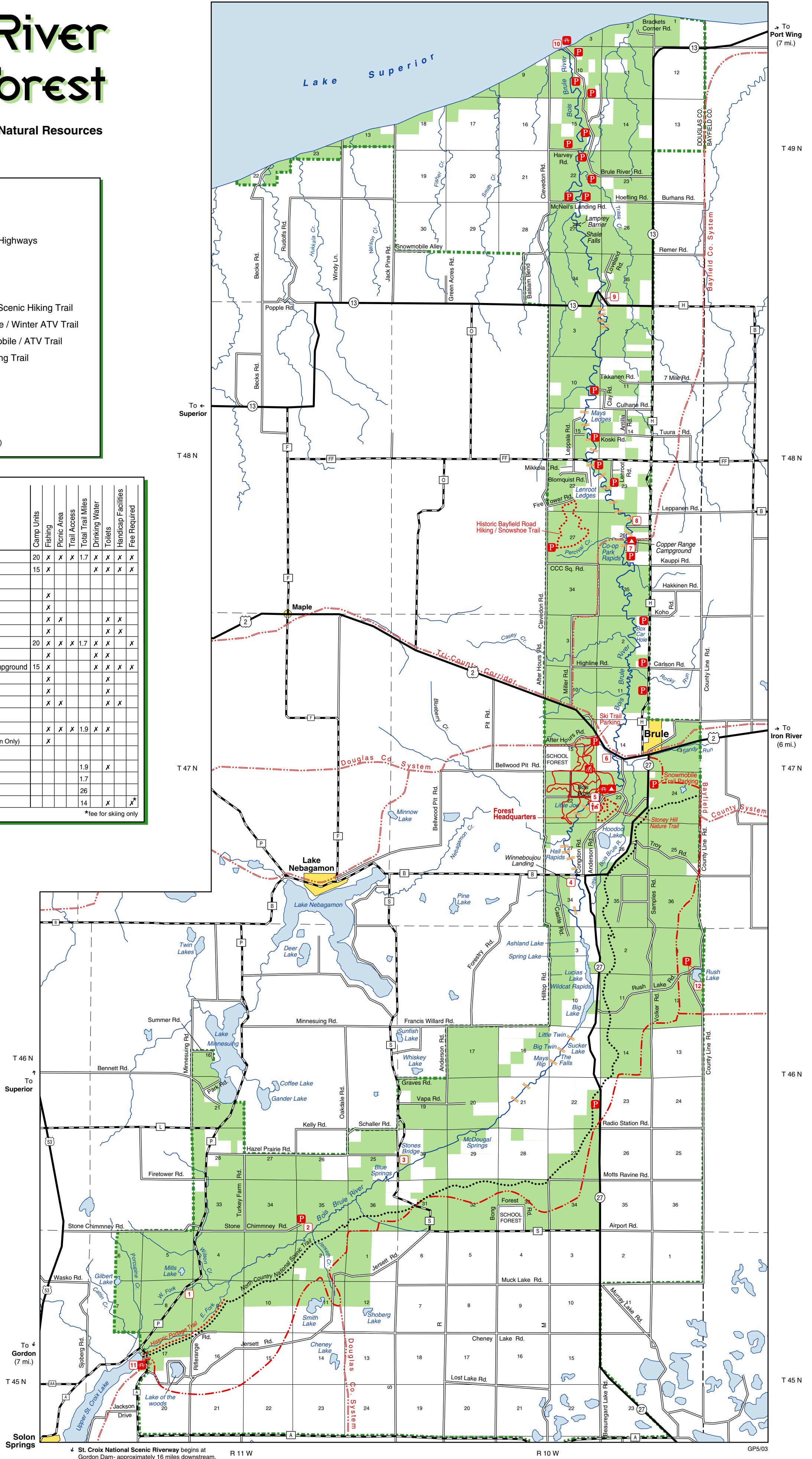
The office is open from 7:45 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily except weekends and holidays.
